1983 - Graduated with a Bachelor of Fine Art from Centre College of Danville, Kentucky.

1984-85 - Pursued a sculpture career while residing in Mt. Shasta, California.

1986 - Apprenticeship with the Louisville bronze sculptor, Barney Bright.

1987-89 - Apprenticeship with the Louisville stone sculptor, Paul Fields.

1990 - Returned to Meade County, Kentucky to pursue a full-time career in stone sculpture from the studio located in Ekron, Kentucky.

2000 - Formed Lawler-White Sculpture Studios, Inc. with corporate partner and wife, Meg White. The primary activity of this corporation is the creation of monumental-scale public sculptures.

2001 - Moved the sculpture studio to the current location near Stephensport, Kentucky. The studio shares space with a 6 acre sculpture garden, adjacent to Yellowbank Wildlife Management Area and overlooking the Ohio River.
